**SUBJECT: Plan of Assessment for ICSE - ART, for the Academic Year 2021-2022**

This is further to our letter dated 6th August 2021, regarding the CISCE's modified plan of assessment for the Academic Year 2021-2022.

**Unlike other subjects, the syllabus for Art has neither been bifurcated nor reduced. For Art, candidates will continue to offer *two papers*, from the choice of papers.**

Additionally, please note the following:

- The CISCE will conduct the Examination for the subject ART **ONLY ONCE** in the month of February/March 2022.
- The schools will be required to conduct the Examination for the ART Papers, on the dates specified by the CISCE.
- The pattern of the Question Papers will be the same as per the existing pattern.
- The CISCE will send the Question Papers to the schools well in time for the teachers concerned to make necessary arrangements.
- The maximum marks for all the ART Papers will be 100 and the time duration will be three hours.
- The schools will be required to send the Answer Scripts of candidates concerned, for ART Papers 1/2/3/4, as applicable, to the office of the CISCE.
- These answer scripts will be evaluated by the examiners appointed by the CISCE.
- For ART Paper 5, the candidates should be Internally Assessed out of 100 Marks (as per the existing pattern). These marks should be uploaded by the schools concerned, on the CAREERS portal, at the end of the academic year, by a date specified by the CISCE.

You are requested to inform all concerned of the above.
