

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES WANTING TO  
**RE-APPEAR** FOR THE ISC EXAMINATION IN THE YEAR 2016

**This information is for the following candidates:**

- (a) Candidates who have not been awarded pass certificates at the ISC Year 2015 Examination or earlier and now wish to appear for the ISC Year 2016 Examination **with regular attendance** at an affiliated school.
- (b) Candidates who have been awarded pass certificates at the ISC Year 2015 Examination or earlier and now wish to appear for the ISC Year 2016 Examination **with regular attendance** at an affiliated school.
- (c) Candidates who have not been awarded pass certificates at the ISC Year 2015 Examination and now wish to appear for the ISC Year 2016 Examination **without attendance** at an affiliated school.
- (d) Candidates who have been awarded pass certificates at the ISC Year 2015 Examination or earlier and now wish to appear for the ISC Year 2016 Examination **without attendance** at an affiliated school.

**Please Note:**

***Candidates who were entered as school candidates, and were not awarded pass certificates, are permitted to re-appear for the examination without further attendance at a Council affiliated school, only once in the immediate year following their failure, but not thereafter.***

**Candidates wishing to appear for ISC Year 2016 Examination with regular attendance at an affiliated school [refer to points (a) & (b) as given above]**

To register for the ISC Year 2016 Examination, the concerned candidates are required to seek admission in an ISC affiliated school.

Please note: Last date for admission to schools is **August 31, 2015**.

**Candidates wishing to appear for ISC Year 2016 Examination without attendance at an affiliated school [refer to points (c) & (d) as given above]**

The concerned candidates are required to register themselves for the ISC Year 2016 Examination through an ISC affiliated School. They are required to contact the Principal of the School, who would forward their entry to the Council through the online portal.

Please note: Last date for submission of entries of these candidates to the Council's office by the Principal through the online portal is **September 15, 2015**.

## **Points to be noted:**

1. Candidates who have not been awarded Pass Certificates will have to compulsorily offer the subject English and three, four or five subjects from the subjects offered by them in the last ISC Examination taken by them as candidates in regular attendance at an affiliated school.
2. Candidates who have been awarded Pass Certificates can offer any/all of the subjects offered by them in the last ISC Examination taken by them as candidates in regular attendance at an affiliated school (provided that the subjects under consideration are still being offered by the Council).
3. Candidates appearing for ISC Year 2016 Examination must follow the Year 2016 Regulations & Syllabuses. **They must carefully go through the syllabuses of the subjects for which they are reappearing in the Year 2016 to ensure that they are fully aware of the changes (if any) in the syllabus/ parts of the syllabus/ textbooks.**
4. Year 2016 Regulations & Syllabuses are available on the Council's website i.e. **[www.cisce.org](http://www.cisce.org)**.
5. For subjects that have a Theory and a Practical component, the candidate is required to appear for **both** the Examination components.
6. From the ISC Year 2016 Examination, in addition to other subjects already having a component of Practical/Project Work, **Project Work carrying 20 Marks has been introduced for the subjects History and Political Science**. All candidates offering these subjects will have to prepare and submit their projects. For further details kindly refer to ISC Year 2016 Regulations and Syllabuses.
7. The Admission Card, Timetable and other information regarding the examination will be sent to the Principal of the School where the candidate's centre for the examination is located, by the last week of January 2016. The candidate may kindly get in touch with the Principal of the school concerned, to collect the Admission Card and a copy of the Timetable.
