You are hereby requested to circulate it among all associated institutions/members, so as to generate awareness regarding foreign policy matters among the youth and ensure maximum participation.

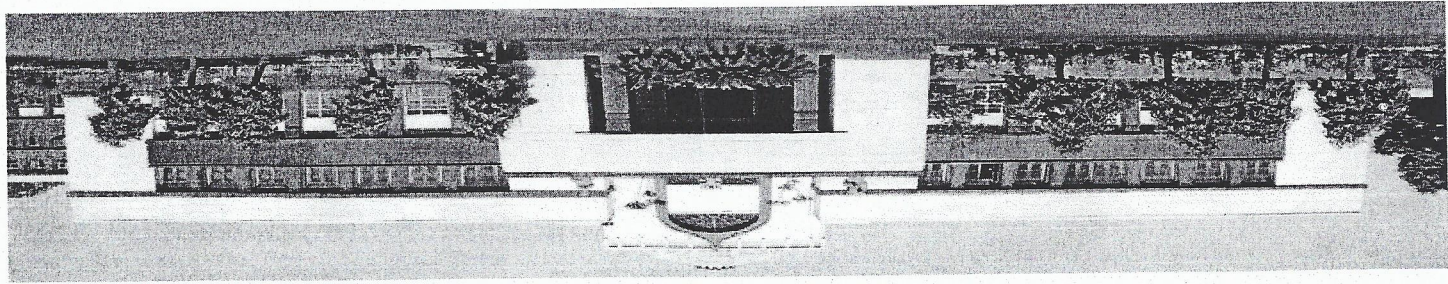

Essay Competition -2016

In order to create awareness about foreign policy issues and generate new ideas from the youth of the country, ICWA announces a the Essay writing contest among the school going students(10-12 standard)-Junior Level and undergraduate and postgraduate students(MA/MSc)-Senior Level. The senior level competition is only for students up to MA/Msc level (M.Phil and Phd. students not allowed) strictly.

Topics

- a) Government's Neighbourhood First Policy: Is it working? (2500 words) – Senior level.
- b) What can India do for the world – Junior level (1500 words).

The entries neatly typed in double space with font size Times New Roman- 12 should reach ICWA by June 30, 2016. Only students whose essays would be shortlisted for further evaluation would be informed by email. Kindly fill all you personal particulars in a cover page (nothing should be written in the essay indicating the name and age or school/college of the participant).

Essays can be written either in English or Hindi.

Prizes

The prize money for Junior Level is be fifteen thousand (15,000/-), ten thousand (10,000/-) and five thousand (5,000/-) respectively for first, second and third position. In case of the Senior Level essay competition the prize money is twenty five thousand (25,000/-), fifteen thousand (15,000/-) and ten thousand (10,000/-) respectively.
